The Data Protection Act 2018, which incorporates the European Union General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) that replaces the 1998 Data Control Regulations is designed for the protection of personal data and preventing it being accessed or used inappropriately, has been embraced by Barnet & Finchley Photographic Society (the "Club").

Information held by the Club is limited to that provided by members when joining the Club and as updated from time to time, together with such contact and membership history that is necessary to allow the efficient running of the Club. It is not passed on by us for use by any other third parties whether or not connected with photography.

Members' personal data collected by the Club is stored securely and is only made available to Club Officials to the extent that is necessary for the performance of their duties.

Members may request that any inaccuracies found in their personal data be corrected without undue delay.

Members may request that their personal data be removed from the Club database at any time, even though such a request will mean that they may no longer be able to participate in all Club activities. Upon receipt of such a request the member's data will be removed without undue delay. The member's name and membership details will be retained for historical purposes only. This will be held on a separate, historical membership database maintained by the Membership Secretary.

The Club will not provide other organisations or individuals with any names or other details of members from the information it holds.

Members are instructed that any personal information of other members provided to them for a specific purpose in connection with the Club must only be used for that purpose and must not be shared for any other reason.
